

# Kris Vallotton: Guvernörs- och presidentprofetior — dokumentation

## Dokumentation

### Inledning

Videoklippet är hämtat ur Richard Moores livesändning från 29 mars 2026 och dokumenterar ett tal Kris Vallotton höll vid Awakening Church's Future Conference. Rapporten återger Vallottons egna utsagor i fyra områden: hans uttalade position om profetiska formuleringar, en profetia om en oidentifierad affärsman, hans offentliga ursäkt efter ett misslyckat Trump-profetia, samt hans teologiska ramverk kring profeter, präster och kungar.

### 1. Intern motsättning: “Thus saith the Lord”

I videoklippets inledning (00:00–01:12) citeras Vallotton som att instämma med teologen Sam Storms om att formuleringen “thus saith the Lord” är ett missbruk av den profetiska gåvan. Vallottons egna ord: “We would never declare 'thus saith the Lord'. I think that's a misuse of the biblical gift of prophecy. [...] If you have a strong sense and impression, you have a very deep conviction in your heart that this may be something the Lord has revealed, but I could be wrong.” Han tillägger att hans församling uppmanar profeternas att låta sig korrigeras: “Don't be nice to me. Tell me if I'm wrong. I want to be held accountable. Judge it. Weigh it. If I missed it you let us know.”

I den efterföljande berättelsen om affärsmannen (se avsnitt 2) använder Vallotton upprepade gånger formuleringen “the Lord told me” — till exempel: “The Lord told me that you're going to be the governor”, “the Lord says to me, 'Tell him he's not just going to be governor'”, och “Tell him I'm not asking him.”

## **2. Gubernatörs- och presidentprofetian**

Vallotton berättar en händelse han daterar till “ungefär 16 år sedan” (ca 2010) och som utspelade sig i ett annat delstat än Kalifornien, dit han flög. Personen i berättelsen — som Vallotton konsekvent vägrar namnge — beskrivs som en mycket förmögen affärsman med en chaufför. Vallotton uppger att han lät sin personliga assistent ringa upp personen för att “he would think I was a powerful person.”

Mötet ägde rum på ett kafé. Vallotton delade en profetia att mannen skulle bli guvernör i sin delstat. Mannens reaktion var att han inte ville bli guvernör och inte ville in i politiken. Vallotton berättar att han i det ögonblicket tog emot ett nytt ord och uppgraderade profetian: mannen skulle inte bara bli guvernör utan president i Förenta staterna. I slutet av mötet, när mannen betalade notan och ville gå, berättar Vallotton att han stod upp och lutade sig framöver bordet och levererade en tredje formulering: “The Lord told me that he's not asking you. He's telling you. And the Lord told me that you are not going to ruin the sovereign history of the United States, because you don't have that much power.” Mannen satte sig ned och de tillbringade sedan resten av dagen tillsammans.

Vallotton uppger att mannen åtta år sedan (2018) valdes till guvernör i sin delstat. När det skedde skickade Vallotton mannen ett textmeddelande med orden “Round one.” Per mars 2026, då videoklippet spelades in, upprätthåller Vallotton att denne man kommer att bli president.

Mannen i berättelsen delade ytterligare detaljer som Vallotton återger: som 8-åring tittade han på en tv-sändning av en presidentdebatt (Nixon kontra Humphrey, 1968) och hörde en röst som sade “Watch this because someday you'll be doing this.” Dessutom hade han, under George W. Bushs presidenttid, besökt Ovalrummet via en vän som arbetade i Vita huset, suttit vid presidentens skrivbord och tänkt “I could do this.” Mannens hund uppges ha burit samma namn som George W. Bushs hund (Barney), vilket mannen märkte när han öppnade en bok om Bush på flyget hem.

Identiteten på mannen i berättelsen förblir okänd. Vallotton lämnar inga namn, och de ledtrådar han ger — förmögen affärsman, vann guvernörsvalet 2018, kom sannolikt österifrån Kalifornien — identifierar ingen person entydigt.

## **3. Trump-profetian och den offentliga ursäkten**

Videoklippet innehåller en inspelning av Vallottons offentliga ursäktvideo från strax efter Joe Bidens valseger 2020. Vallotton redogör för sina profetior om Donald Trump:

Korrekt profetia: Fyra dagar efter att Trump anmälde sitt kandidatur 2015 profeterade Vallotton att han skulle vinna presidentvalet. Detta visade sig stämma.

Felaktig profetia: Vallotton profeterade att Trump inte skulle bli avsatt (impeached) och att han skulle vinna ytterligare en mandatperiod. Denna profetia slogs fel.

I ursäktsvideon säger Vallotton: “I take full responsibility for being wrong. There's no excuse for it. I think it doesn't make me a false prophet, but it does actually create a credibility gap. A lot of people trust me, trust my ministry, and I want to say that I'm very sorry for everyone who put their trust in me.”

Om sin erfarenhet av profetisk verksamhet: “I've prophesied for 14 years in the political realm. This is the very first time I've had to make a public apology for a bad prophetic word that I've given.”

Vallotton hänvisar till att han skrivit tre böcker om profetia och att han i dessa böcker behandlat vad man gör när man missar en profetia. Han avslutar med en uppmaning att be för president Biden och att stödja landets ledare.

#### **4. Teologisk ram: Profeter, präster och kungar**

I slutskedet av talet formulerar Vallotton en bredare teologisk position (25:00–26:44).

Hans ord: “I do believe the Lord has joined the prophets, the priests, and the kings again. I believe that the Lord is calling the Davids out of obscurity — people who would never run for president, people who would never run for mayor or governor or city council. I do believe that God is anointing the prophets again to go call the Davids.”

Vallotton drar en parallell till det gammaltestamentliga smörjelseinstitutet: profeter smörjde kungar, och smörjelsen var det som konstituerade dem som ledare för folket. Han tillämpar detta mönster på nutida politiska kandidater.

#### 1. Bill Lee (Tennessee) — starkaste matchningen

Uppfyller de tre hardaste kriterierna — ar, affärsbakgrund och alder — utan undantag. Ingen kand offentlig Nixon-Humphrey-TV-koppling, men det ar frånvaro av bevis, inte bevis pa frånvaro.

## Nästa testbara steg

Det starkasteenskilda kriteriet for verifiering ar hundens namn. George W. Bushs hundar hette Barney (Scottish Terrier, 2000-2012) och Miss Beazley (Scottish Terrier, 2005-2014). Om nagon av de rankade kandidaterna offentligt namngivit en hund med ett av dessa namn vore det ett starkt indicium. Kontroll av Bill Lee, Doug Burgum och Greg Gianfortes offentliga kommunikation (sociala medier, intervjuer) pa detta kriterium rekommenderas som ett forsta steg.

(00:08:29) ethereal thing or and I'm psychic. I

(00:08:33) public if I ever get a public prophecy  
(00:08:35) wrong, if I ever get a prophecy wrong, I  
(00:08:37) will obviously  
(00:08:39) uh apologize for it. If I get a if I do  
(00:08:41) public prophecy wrong, I will become  
(00:08:43) accountable for it and and I I feel like  
(00:08:46) that's the right thing to do and I want  
(00:08:49) to demonstrate what I've taught for  
(00:08:51) years. It is obviously humiliating.

(00:12:43) And a a little bit frustrated.

(00:13:35) saying  
(00:13:36) he watched the presidential debate as an

(00:15:06) He's got the same name.  
(00:15:11) Of his dog and George  
(00:15:15) Bush. Amazing.  
(00:15:17) Amazing. And then he goes, "But I don't  
(00:15:20) want to be president the United States.  
(00:15:23) And I go, "Okay."  
(00:15:25) So he gets up and finally gets pays the  
(00:15:27) bill.  
(00:15:28) And when he goes to pays the bill, the

(00:15:35) down. The Lord doubles down and says,

(00:16:04) So he comes and you know, sits back down  
(00:16:07) and and the lady brings the bill over  
(00:16:08) and he he he signs the check. And I

(00:16:12) And I stood up and I leaned across the  
(00:16:13) table  
(00:16:15) cuz that's what I felt I was supposed to  
(00:16:16) do.  
(00:16:17) Acting all brave acting all brave, I'm  
(00:16:19) totally terrified. And I go, "The Lord  
(00:16:22) told me that he's not asking you.  
(00:16:26) He's telling you.  
(00:16:28) And the Lord told me that you are not  
(00:16:29) going to ruin the sovereign history of  
(00:16:30) the United States cuz you don't have  
(00:16:32) that much power."  
(00:16:34) And he  
(00:16:39) Bro, what are you talking about, man?  
(00:16:41) The Lord told me  
(00:16:44) that you aren't going to change the  
(00:16:46) sovereign What? Let me finish this.  
(00:16:49) && not asking you.  
(00:16:55) going to ruin the sovereign You are not  
(00:17:01) that much power.

(00:17:25) He becomes the governor of his state. So  
(00:17:27) eight years ago, I have to uh let's see  
(00:17:30) we're 26,  
(00:17:33) so that means  
(00:17:34) um  
(00:17:35) uh  
(00:17:38) that means 18. He got elected as  
(00:17:41) governor of his state in 18.  
(00:17:45) All right. So Tina  
(00:17:48) was  
(00:17:49) Youngkin  
(00:17:52) elected governor of his state in 2018?  
(00:17:56) Of Virginia?  
(00:17:57) So here now  
(00:17:59) I have a few a list of a few governors  
(00:18:03) and um y'all can help me out.  
(00:18:07) Glenn Youngkin was a governor of  
(00:18:09) Virginia former CEO of Carlyle Group, a  
(00:18:12) strong national profile, often discussed  
(00:18:15) as a presidential contender.  
(00:18:19) All right, so then we've got Greg  
(00:18:21) Gianforte.  
(00:18:23) I don't know how to say his last name.  
(00:18:24) Montana, founder of Right Now  
(00:18:26) Technologies, a tech company.  
(00:18:29) No, so Tina is eliminated. Glenn  
(00:18:31) Youngkin. I thought so  
(00:18:34) because  
(00:18:37) I wondered because he's kind of kind of  
(00:18:38) liberal first of all.  
(00:18:40) Um but then um  
(00:18:43) Yeah, so he wasn't elected in 18. So  
(00:18:45) we're looking for someone who's elected  
(00:18:47) eight years ago.  
(00:18:51) am I right with that?  
(00:18:53) Became uh  
(00:18:56) So Greg Gianforte became  
(00:19:01) governor in of Montana  
(00:19:03) Bill Lee of Tennessee  
(00:19:06) construction business and executive Lee

(00:19:09) company.  
(00:19:11) Bill Lee is the the  
(00:19:13) uh governor of Tennessee.  
(00:19:15) Kevin Stitt, Oklahoma, founder of  
(00:19:17) Gateway Mortgage. These are all the  
(00:19:19) current Republicans who have a business  
(00:19:22) background, a wealthy business  
(00:19:24) background, or high profile business  
(00:19:26) background.  
(00:19:28) Uh yeah, Youngkin  
(00:19:30) did become governor.  
(00:19:32) Yeah, that be 18. Oh, so Glenn Youngkin  
(00:19:35) did become governor in 18.  
(00:19:40) He just left office this year, Youngkin,  
(00:19:42) right?  
(00:19:43) Help me out.  
(00:19:45) So, Youngkin was  
(00:19:47) uh elected as governor of Virginia in  
(00:19:50) 2018. Is that correct?  
(00:19:54) Hm, okay. So, we got Democrats. I  
(00:19:56) thought probably not likely that he's  
(00:19:58) talking to any Democrats.  
(00:20:03) Of course, it's all yeah, it's all only  
(00:20:05) if you believe him. I don't know if do  
(00:20:07) we believe Chris Valton? He's telling  
(00:20:09) the story. Um so, he has he has  
(00:20:13) he has prophesied a presidential  
(00:20:16) candidate.  
(00:20:17) Um so, no, Youngkin did not Let me just  
(00:20:20) look.  
(00:20:22) Uh Glenn Youngkin  
(00:20:29) No, he just left office. No, he  
(00:20:32) Uh Glenn Youngkin got elected in 2022.  
(00:20:34) Okay, so that's we eliminate Youngkin.  
(00:20:36) He's not on the list. It's got to be one  
(00:20:37) of these other guys. Um then we got  
(00:20:39) Democrats. I didn't I thought about  
(00:20:41) Democrats because, you know, he's not  
(00:20:43) going to talk to Democrats, but Jay J.B.  
(00:20:45) Pritzker of Illinois, billionaire  
(00:20:47) businessman, Hyatt family, venture  
(00:20:49) capital.

(00:20:50) I cannot imagine he's talking to him,  
(00:20:53) but maybe.  
(00:20:57) so  
(00:20:58) I I I I doubt it, but maybe. Okay, Jared  
(00:21:01) Polis of Colorado, tech entrepreneur,  
(00:21:04) multiple companies.  
(00:21:05) All Dems, okay. So,  
(00:21:08) uh Ned Lamont, Connecticut investment  
(00:21:11) firm founder.  
(00:21:13) These are the only governors that I  
(00:21:16) could imagine  
(00:21:18) J.B. Pritzker did get elected in 2018  
(00:21:21) and is a businessperson.  
(00:21:24) Okay, well,  
(00:21:26) maybe he's talking to a Democrat. I  
(00:21:28) cannot imagine that he's prophesying  
(00:21:31) that a Democrat  
(00:21:33) will be president and that  
(00:21:35) he can't do anything cuz he's be  
(00:21:36) breaking the sovereign plan of the  
(00:21:38) United States, but  
(00:21:43) I mean, who else could it be? I don't  
(00:21:44) have any idea. I looked up the people  
(00:21:46) who have business backgrounds and these  
(00:21:49) are the ones that that came up. I I  
(00:21:52) didn't look at all 50.  
(00:21:56) But,  
(00:21:57) yeah.  
(00:22:00) Yeah, I sure hope not with J- J.B.  
(00:22:01) Pritzker, too. But,  
(00:22:04) that's the one who got elected in '18.  
(00:22:06) Did any of those others did did uh Jared  
(00:22:09) Polis of Colorado get elected in Can  
(00:22:11) anybody look these up for me real quick?  
(00:22:14) I don't know. We'll figure it out.  
(00:22:16) But, um  
(00:22:18) yeah, he's prophesying the next I don't  
(00:22:20) know, he didn't say the next president,  
(00:22:21) but he said, "You'll This person who you  
(00:22:23) talked to will be president."  
(00:22:26) And if he if he's not that it will break  
(00:22:29) the sovereign

(00:22:31) um plan of God for the United States.  
(00:22:33) Blah, blah, blah. I mean, seriously,  
(00:22:35) bro. Are you serious?  
(00:22:37) && Yeah. Maybe not the next president, but  
(00:22:39) he will be president, whoever this guy  
(00:22:41) is.  
(00:22:42) And if we can unearth it and see  
(00:22:45) who he was talking to,  
(00:22:47) yeah, it'd be very interesting. All  
(00:22:48) right, so let's see. Ron DeSantis was  
(00:22:51) elected first term in 2018. Could be  
(00:22:53) DeSantis. DeSantis had a had a business  
(00:22:55) background, yeah?  
(00:22:59) he ran, though. He also ran and  
(00:23:02) did not  
(00:23:04) he didn't make it very far even in the  
(00:23:05) in the  
(00:23:08) prelims. So, let's see here.  
(00:23:11) Could be DeSantis.  
(00:23:13) Um maybe he's remembering the years  
(00:23:15) wrong.  
(00:23:17) When I said 18, I meant yes, 18 was 8

(00:23:27) Could be DeSantis. He's Republican.  
(00:23:29) Um I was kind of pulling for DeSantis in  
(00:23:31) the last term turn around, but  
(00:23:35) All Chris.  
(00:23:37) AI says Chris met with Youngkin in 2021.  
(00:23:41) Okay.  
(00:23:42) Interesting.  
(00:23:45) Yeah, so whoever it is, guys, he has  
(00:23:48) said he has prophesied that he will be  
(00:23:50) president. If it was DeSantis,  
(00:23:53) he will be a president.  
(00:23:55) And I text him. I go,  
(00:23:57) "Round one."  
(00:23:58) for what when he runs  
(00:24:02) He becomes the governor of his state.  
(00:24:09) He texted him. He text he texted this  
(00:24:11) governor when he became governor and he  
(00:24:13) said, "This is round one." Meaning,

(00:24:16) you're up for president now.  
(00:24:21) He's not president yet. Yeah, so Lambert  
(00:24:24) says that  
(00:24:25) DeSantis was not business, he was  
(00:24:28) attorney, military, and politician. Um  
(00:24:30) so, yeah.  
(00:24:32) Or he's lying. Or Chris Fulton's lying.  
(00:24:35) So, we'll see how that goes. At least I  
(00:24:37) got part right one right, you know?  
(00:24:40) At least I got part one right. So, he is  
(00:24:43) a current governor or  
(00:24:45) what was it got elected as a governor.  
(00:24:48) I do believe the Lord has joined the  
(00:24:50) prophets, the priests, and the kings  
(00:24:51) again.  
(00:24:52) I believe  
(00:24:57) that the Lord has joined the prophets,  
(00:24:58) priests, and kings? Nope. I do believe  
(00:25:00) that the Lord is calling the Davids out  
(00:25:02) of obscurity. People who would never run  
(00:25:05) for president, people who would never  
(00:25:06) run for mayor You're not David, dude. I

(00:25:16) The Davids, God's calling the Davids out  
(00:25:18) of obscurity.  
(00:25:21) You're not David. Yeah, there's probably  
(00:25:23) about a 99% chance he's a liar.  
(00:25:25) He's lying. Though, there's a 100%  
(00:25:27) chance he is a liar. He is a liar. This  
(00:25:29) guy's a liar. Chris Vallotton's a liar.  
(00:25:31) And there's probably a 99% chance he's  
(00:25:33) lying in this situation.  
(00:25:35) &gt;&gt; mayor, or governor, or city council. I  
(00:25:37) do believe that God is anointing the  
(00:25:39) prophets again to go call the Davids,  
(00:25:41) call He's anointing the prophets again.  
(00:25:43) Folks, what happened when a prophet,  
(00:25:45) priest, or a king in the Old Testament  
(00:25:47) was anointed? What made them

(00:26:12) He's saying that these people will be  
(00:26:13) national leaders. This is unbelievable,  
(00:26:15) man. This is unbelievable. Nope.  
(00:26:18) God is not restoring the priesthood, my  
(00:26:20) friends,  
(00:26:21) or the prophet,  
(00:26:22) or the king.  
(00:26:25) Not anointed kings.  
(00:26:29) Israel had them. We have elders,  
(00:26:32) deacons, and pastors.
